

Ambon - Neira - Misool (Ambon to Sorong) 30+ dives recommended Open water Diver or equivalent required

10 Nights/11 Days | Up to 31 dives Day 1: Embarkation: Ambon (AMQ)

Guest arrival in Ambon and embarkation on Malaillo before 2:00 PM, followed by a check dive in Laha, located inside Ambon Bay. The check dive will depend on the latest guest arrival time (1 dive).

Day 2: Pulau Suanggi & Banda Naira (4 dives)

Enjoy stunning reef dives around Pulau Suanggi with a chance to spot schooling hammerhead sharks. End the day with a night dive near Banda Naira.

Day 3: Banda Naira & Pohon Miring (3 dives)

Start the day with a land excursion to Fort Belgica, a historic Dutch fortress, followed by two dives around Batu Kapal and Pohon Miring. One night dive will complete the day.

Day 4: Hatta Island to Pulau Koon (3 dives)

Morning dive at Karang Hatta Atoll, followed by two more dives on Hatta Island. No night dive as we sail overnight to Pulau Koon.

Day 5: Pulau Koon (2 dives)

Two dives at Pulau Koon, famous for schooling fish such as trevally, barracuda, batfish, black snapper, and bumphead parrotfish.

Day 6: Misool: Fiabacet Area (4 dives)

Dive into the heart of biodiversity with three exceptional dives at Fiabacet, followed by a night dive.

Day 7: Warakaraket Area (Magic Mountain & Boo Islands) (4 dives)

Begin at Magic Mountain, where both reef and oceanic mantas are often seen. Then explore Boo Windows and Boo East. Wrap up the day with a night dive.

Day 8: Wayil (4 dives)

First dive at The Four Kings (four spectacular pinnacles), followed by Orange Peel and

Wedding Cake—both offering vibrant walls and ridges covered in soft coral. End the day with a night dive.

Day 9: Daram (4 dives)

Dive the rich waters of Daram, known for dramatic pinnacles and coral-covered ridges teeming with marine life.

Day 10: Batanta Island (2 dives)

Conclude your diving with two muck dives around Batanta Island, a haven for critters and macro enthusiasts.

Day 11 – Disembarkation Sorong (SOQ)

Guests disembark Malaillo by 11:00 AM. Transfers to Sorong Airport or hotels will be arranged.Important: The last dive of the trip will take place on Day 10. Divers are strongly advised to observe a 24-hour surface interval before flying.

Travel Tip:

ARRIVAL DATE: We highly recommend arriving in the city of embarkation one day prior to the cruise departure and staying at a local hotel. This provides flexibility in the event of unexpected flight or luggage delays, or cancellations.

DEPARTURE DATE: We strongly advise against booking international flights on the same day as disembarkation, to ensure a smooth and stress-free transfer.
