Banda Neira – Misool 10 Nights / 11 Days | Up to 30 Dives

Trip Overview:

This spectacular crossing expedition connects the historic Banda Sea with the world-renowned reefs of Misool, Raja Ampat. The journey combines remote oceanic atolls, legendary hammerhead shark hotspots, manta cleaning stations, pristine coral ecosystems, and world-class reef structures.

From the cultural heritage of Banda Neira to the biodiversity-rich waters of Misool, this itinerary delivers an exceptional balance of pelagic encounters, reef exploration, and dramatic underwater landscapes.

Day 1: Embarkation – Ambon (AMQ)

Guests arrive in Ambon (AMQ) and board Malaillo before 14:00 for check-in, safety briefing, and dive orientation.

Depending on arrival time and sea conditions, a check dive will be conducted in **Laha Bay**, located inside Ambon Bay and famous for its exceptional muck diving and macro biodiversity.

Day 2: Pulau Suanggi & Banda Neira | 4 Dives

Begin the expedition at Pulau Suanggi, one of the Banda Sea's premier sites for potential encounters with schooling hammerhead sharks.

The dives feature healthy coral reefs, strong pelagic influence, and abundant reef fish activity. In the evening, enjoy a night dive in the waters surrounding Banda Neira, offering a unique nocturnal reef experience.

Day 3: Banda Neira Exploration | 3 Dives + Cultural Excursion

Start the day with a guided visit to **Fort Belgica**, a historic Dutch fortress overlooking Banda Neira. Continue diving at:

- **Batu Kapal** – a striking pinnacle and reef system with rich marine life
- **Pohon Miring** – a beautiful wall dive with swim-throughs and soft coral formations

The day concludes with a night dive in the Banda Neira area.

Day 4: Hatta Island to Pulau Koon | 3 Dives

Begin with a morning dive at **Karang Hatta Atoll**, followed by two dives around **Hatta Island**, known for its vibrant reefs and strong pelagic presence.

No night dive is scheduled as the vessel begins its overnight crossing toward Pulau Koon

Day 5: Pulau Koon | 2 Dives

Explore **Pulau Koon**, a renowned aggregation site for schooling fish in the Banda Sea. Expect impressive schools of:

- Giant trevally
- Barracuda
- Batfish
- Black snapper
- Bumphead parrotfish

This site is known for strong currents and exceptional fish density.

Day 6: Fiabacet Area (Misool) | 4 Dives

Enter the heart of Misool's biodiversity at the legendary **Fiabacet area**.

This region is known for its pristine coral reefs, dramatic underwater topography, and outstanding marine life. Divers can expect vibrant soft corals, schooling reef fish, and frequent pelagic activity, followed by a night dive in the area.

Day 7: Warakaraket Area (Magic Mountain & Boo Islands) | 4 Dives

Start at Magic Mountain, one of Raja Ampat's most iconic manta cleaning stations, where both reef and oceanic mantas are commonly encountered.

Continue to:

- Boo Windows – famous swim-through formations and coral-covered walls
- Boo East – rich reef ecosystems and excellent coral diversity

End the day with a night dive in Misool waters.

Day 8: Wayil | 4 Dives

Explore the dramatic seascape of Wayil, featuring some of Misool's most iconic dive sites:

- The Four Kings – four spectacular pinnacles teeming with life
- Orange Peel – ridge systems covered in vibrant soft corals
- Wedding Cake – colorful reef structures and excellent biodiversity

The day concludes with a night dive.

Day 9: Daram | 4 Dives

Dive the pristine reefs of Daram Island, known for its coral-covered pinnacles, healthy reef systems, and abundant fish life.

This area consistently offers excellent visibility and strong marine biodiversity.

Day 10: Daram | 2 Dives

Spend a final morning diving around Daram, enjoying two relaxed dives to conclude the underwater portion of the expedition.

After diving, the vessel begins its final passage toward Sorong.

Day 11: Disembarkation (Sorong) | SOQ

Please note that the latest disembarkation from Malaillo is **11:00 AM**. Guests with later departing flights will be transferred directly to the Airport at 11:00 AM, while guests with confirmed transit hotel reservations will be transferred to their respective hotels following disembarkation. No onboard stay is available after 11:00 AM.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

***Flying After Diving:** The last dive of the trip will take place on Day 10. Divers are strongly advised to observe a 24-hour surface interval before flying.*

Travel Tip:

***Arrival Recommendation:** We highly recommend arriving in the city of embarkation one day prior to the cruise departure and staying at a local hotel. This provides flexibility in the event of unexpected flight or luggage delays, or cancellations.*

***Departure Recommendation:** We strongly advise against booking international flights on the same day as disembarkation, to ensure a smooth and stress-free transfer.*
