

Halmahera - Lembeh (Ternate to Bitung) 30+ dives recommended Open water Diver or equivalent required

6 Nights/7 Days| Up to 19 Dives Day 1 – Embarkation - Ternate Harbor (TTE)

Guests embark at Ternate Harbor. After the general boat and dive briefing, the trip begins with a check dive. A night dive may also be scheduled depending on arrival time.

Day 2 – Jailolo (4 Dives)

Explore amazing reef dives featuring walls and sloping reefs with healthy hard coral gardens teeming with Anthias. Common sightings include Blacktip Reef Sharks, Napoleon Wrasse, and Trevallies.

Day 3 – Tifure (4 Dives)

Located between Ternate and Bitung, Tifure offers spectacular dives. Expect steep slopes, vibrant hard corals, and a high chance of encountering large schools of Barracuda, Napoleon Wrasse, Reef Sharks, and Turtles.

Day 4 – Bangka Island (4 Dives)

Dive 1: Batu Goso Dive 2: Sahaung Dive 3: Batu Mandi Night Dive: Batu Mandi

Day 5 – Lembeh (4 Dives)

Dive 1: Batu Pendeta Dive 2: Angel's Window Dive 3: Teluk Kambahu Night Dive: Teluk Kambahu

Day 6 – Lembeh (2 Dives)

Dive 1: Jahir Dive 2: Serena

Enjoy the final dives in the world-famous Lembeh Strait, known for its rich muck diving and rare critter sightings.

Day 7 – Disembarkation - Bitung Harbor (MDC)

Guests disembark by 11:00 AM at Bitung Harbor and will be escorted to Manado airport (MDC) or city hotels for onward travel. Important: The last dive of the trip will take place on Day 7. Divers are strongly

advised to observe a 24-hour surface interval before flying.

Travel Tip:

ARRIVAL DATE: We highly recommend arriving in the city of embarkation one day prior to the cruise departure and staying at a local hotel. This provides flexibility in the event of unexpected flight or luggage delays, or cancellations.

DEPARTURE DATE: We strongly advise against booking international flights on the same day as disembarkation, to ensure a smooth and stress-free transfer.
