Crossing Trip: Alor & Banda Sea – 11D/10N | Up to 27 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Mali Airport (ARD), Alor, or nearby hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 11 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Ambon the night before. Transfers to Pattimura Airport (AMQ), Ambon, or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 10. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Arrival & Check-In

Welcome aboard Neptune One in Alor. After safety briefings and cabin check-in, we'll offer a relaxed check dive to ensure your gear and buoyancy are all set for the journey ahead.

Day 2 (Up to 3 dives) – Alor Region

Start your expedition with incredible coral gardens, thriving reef fish, and excellent macro subjects. Expect pristine reefs, calm conditions, and great visibility.

Day 3 (Up to 3 dives) – Reong

Dive into dramatic walls and sloping reefs teeming with anthias, nudibranchs, and the occasional pelagic visitor. Coral health is excellent, offering both wide-angle and macro photo opportunities.

Day 4 (Up to 3 dives) – Nyata

Enjoy varied terrain including reef corners and coral slopes. Schools of snappers, reef sharks, turtles, and vibrant sponges are commonly seen. Currents may bring in more action.

Day 5 (Up to 3 dives) – Nusleur

Today features ridge dives and vibrant reef systems with both hard and soft corals. Highlights may include reef fish swarms, occasional sea snakes, and colorful reef critters.

Day 6 (Up to 3 dives) – Banda Sea

You'll dive remote seamounts rising from the deep, often with crystal-clear visibility. Sites here are known for strong currents, schooling barracuda, and occasional hammerhead sightings during the season.

**Day 7 (Up to 4 dives) – Serua**

A full day of diving around nutrient-rich drop-offs and vibrant coral formations. Expect diverse marine life, excellent visibility, and opportunities for large fish encounters.

Day 8 (Up to 4 dives) – Manuk

An extraordinary dive experience near an active volcanic island. The area is famous for geothermal bubbles, dramatic underwater landscapes, and the chance to dive with sea snakes in crystal-clear waters.

Day 9 (Up to 3 dives + land excursion) – Banda Neira

Dive into history and coral beauty. This day includes colorful reef dives and a visit to Fort Belgica, an old Dutch fortress. The mix of culture and diving makes for a memorable stop.

Day 10 (2 dives) – Suanggi

Wrap up your adventure with exhilarating dives featuring fast-moving currents, schooling fusiliers, and possible pelagics. Expect high fish biomass and dramatic topography.

Day 11 – Disembarkation

Enjoy a final breakfast before transferring to Ambon airport or hotel. No diving this day due to surface interval.

- **Water Temperature:** 27°C – 30°C
- **Visibility:** 20 – 35 meters
- **Currents:** Mild to strong depending on the site
- **Recommended Certification:** Advanced Open Water
- **Minimum Experience:** 20 logged dives

What to Bring

- Dive certification card & logbook
- Dive computer & surface marker buoy (required)
- Reef-safe sunscreen
- Swimwear, hat, sunglasses
- Light clothing & comfortable footwear
- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
