Crossing Trip: Alor to Wakatobi – 10D/9N | Up to 25 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Mali Airport (ARD), Alor, or nearby hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 10 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Bau Bau the night before. Transfers to Betoambari Airport (BUW), Bau Bau, or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 9. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Arrival & Check-In

Welcome aboard Neptune One in Alor. After settling into your cabin and a safety briefing, gear up for a relaxed check dive to familiarize yourself with the environment and equipment.

Day 2 (Up to 4 dives) – Pura Island

Enjoy clear waters with dramatic reef walls, bommies, and marine life ranging from pygmy seahorses to passing pelagics. The coral diversity here is exceptional, and you may encounter vibrant schools of reef fish and critter-rich slopes.

Day 3 (Up to 3 dives) – Pura Island

Dive sites today feature steep drop-offs, swim-throughs, and colorful coral gardens. Look out for frogfish, nudibranchs, and ribbon eels. The occasional reef shark or turtle may also make an appearance.

Day 4 (Up to 2 dives + land excursion) – Sika & Pantar Islands

Explore a mix of wall dives and reef plateaus filled with macro subjects and larger fish action. In the afternoon, enjoy a cultural village visit and keep an eye out for dugongs known to frequent the bay.

Day 5 (Up to 3 dives) – Komba Volcano

Experience thrilling dives around an active volcano, where black sand slopes are home to fascinating macro life. Dramatic lava-formed rock structures and geothermal bubbles create an otherworldly atmosphere underwater.

**Day 6 (Up to 4 dives) – Tomia & Karang Sawa**

Enter Wakatobi National Park. These reefs offer high visibility, vibrant coral gardens, and high fish density. Expect large schools of anthias, occasional barracudas, and pristine reef architecture.

Day 7 (Up to 3 dives) – Tomia

Continue exploring the healthy and colorful reefs of Tomia. Sites feature coral slopes, bommies, and ridges where you may encounter eagle rays, giant trevallies, and turtles gliding through calm waters.

Day 8 (Up to 4 dives) – Hoga

Hoga's underwater seascape is a paradise for photographers. Dive into rich biodiversity zones with varied topography, macro critters, sea fans, and dense coral coverage. Dives range from gentle drifts to sheltered ridges.

Day 9 (2 dives) – Wangi-Wangi

Your final dives feature classic Wakatobi conditions: calm, warm waters with excellent visibility, vibrant reef life, and soft coral carpets. A perfect way to close out the underwater adventure.

Day 10 – Disembarkation

Enjoy a final breakfast before transferring to Bau Bau airport or hotel. No diving today due to surface interval.

- Water Temperature: 27°C – 30°C
- Visibility: 20 – 35 meters
- Currents: Mild to moderate depending on the site
- Recommended Certification: Advanced Open Water
- Minimum Experience: 20 logged dives

What to Bring

- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
