Ambon to Sorong Expedition – 11D/10N | Up to 27 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation:

Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Pattimura Airport (AMQ), Ambon, or local hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation begins once all guests have arrived. Schedule may adjust depending on flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation:

Day 11 by 10:00 AM. The boat arrives in Sorong the night before. Transfers to Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ) or local hotels are included.

Last Dive:

Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 10. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather, sea conditions, and optimal diving opportunities. Dive counts are approximate and may adjust accordingly.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Ambon

Guest arrival, check-in, and boat briefing. If time permits, one check dive will be conducted to explore Ambon's famous muck environment, home to unique macro life such as rhinopias, frogfish, ghost pipefish, and colorful nudibranchs.

Day 2 (Up to 3 dives) – Nusa Laut

Enjoy beautifully preserved reefs with exceptional visibility. Expect vibrant hard coral gardens, turtles, sea snakes, and dense schools of reef fish in calm, clear water.

Day 3 (Up to 4 dives) – Suanggi

Experience high-energy dives with strong currents that attract large pelagics. Divers may encounter schooling barracuda, trevallies, tunas, and occasional hammerhead sightings.



Day 4 (3 dives) – Run & Ai Islands

Explore dramatic walls and slopes covered in soft corals and barrel sponges. These nutrient-rich waters often bring in eagle rays, reef sharks, and large schools of fusiliers and snappers.

Day 5 (3 dives + land tour) – Banda Neira

Dive among volcanic formations and coral-rich slopes teeming with anthias, reef fish, and macro subjects. Sheltered areas may reveal mandarin fish and other small critters. In the afternoon, enjoy a historical city tour of Banda Neira.

Day 6 (3 dives) – Hatta Island

Discover crystal-clear waters with excellent visibility and colorful coral gardens. Expect reef sharks, schooling surgeonfish, turtles, and the possibility of pygmy seahorses on steep walls.

Day 7 (2 dives) – Koon

Known for big-fish action, Koon offers powerful currents that attract large schools of jacks, snappers, and barracuda. Soft coral slopes and vibrant fish life create spectacular scenes underwater.

Day 8 (Up to 4 dives) – Daram, Misool

Enter one of Misool's most beautiful regions, filled with soft coral gardens, sea fans, and dense fish activity. Look out for turtles, sweetlips, batfish, and thriving reef ecosystems in crystal-clear waters.

Day 9 (Up to 4 dives) – Warakaraket, Misool

A biodiversity hotspot featuring seamounts with swirling fish schools, soft coral draped ridges, and encounters with reef sharks. Manta rays are also possible during the season.

Day 10 (2 dives) – Misool

Your final dives showcase Misool's iconic underwater landscapes—massive coral formations, wobbegong sharks, batfish schools, and stunning coral slopes perfect for relaxed final dives. End the day with an 18–24 hour surface interval before disembarkation.

Day 11 – Sorong Disembarkation

Early breakfast followed by check-out and transfer to Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ) or your hotel. No diving today due to flight time.



Diving Conditions

- **Best Time to Dive:** March–April, September–November
- **Water Temperature:** 27°C – 30°C
- **Visibility:** 15 – 30 meters
- **Currents:** Mild to strong depending on site
- **Recommended Certification:** Advanced Open Water
- **Minimum Experience:** 20 dives (experience in currents recommended)
