Bali to Komodo Expedition – 10D/9N | Up to 25 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Denpasar Ngurah Rai International Airport (DPS) or local hotels in Bali. Guests must gather at the designated harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once all guests are onboard. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 10 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Labuan Bajo the night before. Transfers to Komodo Airport (LBJ) or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 9. Please allow 18–24 hours of surface interval before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather, sea conditions, and optimal diving opportunities. The number of dives is approximate and may be adjusted accordingly.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Bali

Arrival and check-in. Afternoon check dive near Bali to ensure equipment setup and comfort in the water.

Day 2 (3 dives) – Gili Islands

Explore Shark Point, the Bounty Wreck, and Turtle Heaven—known for coral gardens, green turtles, and reef sharks.

Day 3 (3 dives) – Moyo Island

Dive Angel Reef and Long Reef with clear visibility and abundant reef life. Night dive at Moyo Jetty.

Day 4 (3 dives + trekking) – Saleh Bay & Satonda

Morning dive with potential whale shark sightings, followed by trekking to Satonda Crater Lake. Afternoon dive at Satonda Jetty.

Day 5 (3 dives) – Sangeang Volcano

Dives at Deep Purple, Techno Reef, and Lighthouse. Expect volcanic sand slopes, hydrothermal bubbles, and vibrant macro life.

**Day 6 (4 dives) – North Komodo**

Dives at Batu Monco, Castle Rock, Shotgun, and Komodo Bay. Schools of trevallies, reef sharks, and manta sightings are possible.

Day 7 (3 dives + trekking) – North Komodo

Dive Crystal Rock and Batu Bolong—two of Komodo's most iconic sites. Afternoon hike to Padar viewpoint followed by a dive at Padar Kecil.

Day 8 (3 dives) – Central Komodo

Dive manta-rich Taka Makassar, current-swept Mawan, and macro haven Wainilu.

Day 9 (2 dives + trekking) – Central Komodo

Trek to see the legendary Komodo dragons in the morning. Final dives at Pengah Kecil and Siaba Besar.

Day 10 – Labuan Bajo

Early breakfast and check-out. Transfer to Komodo Airport (LBJ) or hotel. No diving this day due to surface interval requirements.

Diving Conditions

Best Time to Dive: April to November

Water Temperature: 26°C – 29°C

Visibility: 15 – 30 meters

Currents: Mild to strong depending on the site

Recommended Certification: Advanced Open Water

Minimum Experience: 20 dives with some current experience preferred

What to Bring

- Dive certification card & logbook
- Dive computer & surface marker buoy (required)
- Reef-safe sunscreen
- Swimwear, hat, sunglasses
- Light clothing & comfortable footwear
- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
