Crossing Trip: Banda Sea to Triton Bay – 11D/10N | Up to 27 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Pattimura Airport (AMQ), Ambon, or nearby hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 11 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Kaimana the night before. Transfers to Utarom Airport (KNG), Kaimana, or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 10. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Arrival & Check-In

Welcome aboard Neptune One in Ambon. After your welcome briefing and gear setup, enjoy a relaxed check dive to start your journey with confidence.

Day 2 (Up to 3 dives) – Banda Sea

Begin diving in warm, clear waters with stunning coral slopes and high marine biodiversity. Expect healthy reefs, good visibility, and the chance to see large schools of reef fish and pelagics.

Day 3 (Up to 4 dives) – Banda Sea

Dive steep walls, volcanic ridges, and nutrient-rich drop-offs. These sites often deliver pelagic action and exciting reef life in every direction.

Day 4 (Up to 3 dives + land tour) – Banda Neira

Today combines world-class diving and cultural heritage. Explore vibrant reef systems in the morning, and visit a historical spice island village and colonial fort in the afternoon.

Day 5 (Up to 3 dives) – Outer Islands

Enjoy deep reef walls, schooling fish, and thrilling underwater terrain. Large sponges and black coral trees decorate the landscape, while reef sharks and turtles may glide by.

Day 6 (Up to 3 dives) – Volcanic Island

Dive around an active volcano known for geothermal bubbles and thriving reefs. Keep an eye out for sea snakes, swirling baitballs, and dramatic seascapes formed by ancient lava flows.

**Day 7 (Up to 3 dives) – Koon Region**

Today offers colorful reefs teeming with fish. Current-fed sites attract predators like jacks and trevally, while reef corners are filled with vibrant coral and small critters.

Day 8 (Up to 3 dives + land excursion) – Momon

Explore gentle reef slopes and ridges packed with soft coral and macro life. Between dives, enjoy a scenic freshwater waterfall hidden in the jungle just steps from the beach.

Day 9 (Up to 4 dives) – Triton Bay

Welcome to a remote diving paradise. Dive into soft coral gardens, black coral forests, and hidden corners filled with rare macro species. Keep your eyes open for turtles, reef sharks, and swarming reef fish.

Day 10 (Up to 2 dives) – Triton Bay

Your final dives feature nutrient-rich reefs and the chance for encounters with schooling fish and curious megafauna. A peaceful way to end your journey through the Banda Sea.

Day 11 – Disembarkation

Enjoy your final breakfast onboard before transfer to Kaimana airport or hotel. No diving today due to flight surface interval.

- **Best Time to Dive:** October to April
- **Water Temperature:** 27°C – 30°C
- **Visibility:** 15 – 30 meters
- **Currents:** Mild to strong depending on the site
- **Recommended Certification:** Advanced Open Water
- **Minimum Experience:** 20 logged dives

- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
