Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation:

Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Komodo Airport (LBJ), Labuan Bajo, or local hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation:

Day 8 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Labuan Bajo the night before. Transfers to Komodo Airport (LBJ) or local hotels are included.

Last Dive:

Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 7. Please allow 18–24 hours of surface interval before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather, sea conditions, and optimal diving opportunities. The number of dives is approximate and may be adjusted accordingly.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Labuan Bajo

Arrival and check-in onboard. Afternoon check dive to get comfortable in the water.

Day 2 (3 dives + hike) – Central Komodo

Dives at Siaba Besar, Mawan, and Secret Garden. Afternoon hike to Padar Island viewpoint.

Day 3 (4 dives) – South Komodo

Dive iconic sites like Manta Alley, Loh Sera Bay, and Piggy Beach. Expect manta rays, stunning coral, and cool waters.

Day 4 (3 dives + beach walk) – North Komodo

Dives at Ndihiang, Pink Beach, and Lasa. Enjoy a relaxing beach walk at Pink Beach.

Day 5 (3 dives) – North Komodo

High-voltage dives at Shotgun, Castle Rock, and Crystal Rock with chances to see big pelagics, reef sharks, and swirling schools of fish.

Day 6 (4 dives) – North Komodo

Dives at Tatawa Besar, Batu Bolong, Tatawa Kecil, and Wainilu. From mantas and turtles to critters and vibrant coral.

**Day 7 (2 dives + trek) – Central Komodo**

Morning dives at Police Corner and Pengah Kecil. Trekking with Komodo dragons in the afternoon.

Day 8 – Labuan Bajo

Early breakfast, check-out, and transfer to the airport or hotel. No diving on this day due to flight time.

Diving Conditions

Best Time to Dive: April to November

Water Temperature: 26°C – 29°C

Visibility: 15 – 30 meters

Currents: Mild to strong depending on site

Recommended Certification: Advanced Open Water

Minimum Experience: 20 dives with some current experience preferred

What to Bring

- Dive certification card & logbook
- Dive computer & surface marker buoy (required)
- Reef-safe sunscreen
- Swimwear, hat, sunglasses
- Light clothing & comfortable footwear
- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
