Crossing Trip: Triton Bay to Misool – 11D/10N | Up to 27 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Utarom Airport (KNG), Kaimana, or nearby hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 11 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Sorong the night before. Transfers to Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ), Sorong, or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 10. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1 (0 dives) – Arrival & Check-In

Welcome aboard Neptune One in Kaimana. After settling into your cabin and completing safety briefings, relax and enjoy your first evening as we set sail toward the diving frontier of Triton Bay.

Day 2 (Up to 4 dives) – Triton Bay

Start your journey in one of Indonesia's most remote and biodiverse regions. Dive into soft coral wonderlands, towering black coral bushes, and shallow reefs teeming with anthias and damselfish. You may spot bumphead parrotfish, mobula rays, or even whale sharks.

Day 3 (Up to 3 dives) – Triton Bay

Experience nutrient-rich waters that attract dense schools of fish. Explore walls, bommies, and sloping reefs filled with macro critters, vibrant sponges, and occasional pelagic visitors.

Day 4 (Up to 4 dives + land excursion) – Momon

Continue diving vibrant ridges and coral-covered slopes full of tropical marine life. Between dives, enjoy a refreshing jungle trek to a stunning coastal waterfall hidden in the forest.

Day 5 (Up to 3 dives) – Pulau Pisang

This area offers dramatic underwater topography, including submerged pinnacles, bommies, and reef plateaus. You can expect excellent visibility and sightings of jacks, snappers, reef sharks, and a variety of invertebrates.

Day 6 (Up to 4 dives) – Misool

Enter the southern reaches of Raja Ampat, home to some of the richest coral biodiversity on



Earth. Enjoy colorful soft coral forests, sea fans, schooling fish, reef sharks, and macro subjects like pygmy seahorses and nudibranchs.

Day 7 (Up to 4 dives) – Misool

Explore Misool's iconic seascapes including steep walls, overhangs, cleaning stations, and coral-covered ridges. Look out for manta rays, fusiliers, turtles, and patrolling pelagics in these world-class dive sites.

Day 8 (Up to 2 dives + land tour) – Misool

Your morning dives will feature stunning coral landscapes and large marine life encounters. In the afternoon, enjoy a short trek to the breathtaking Love Lagoon viewpoint.

Day 9 (Up to 3 dives + land tour) – Penemu

Head into the Central Raja Ampat region. Dive among pristine hard coral gardens, thriving fish schools, and intricate reef structures. End the day with a panoramic hike to the famous Penemu viewpoint.

Day 10 (2 dives + beach stop) – Dampier Strait

Conclude your diving in some of Raja Ampat's most celebrated sites. Expect thrilling drifts, high fish biomass, and massive coral formations. Wrap up your day with a sunset visit to a remote sandbar.

Day 11 – Disembarkation

Enjoy a final breakfast onboard before your transfer to Sorong airport or hotel. No diving this day due to surface interval requirements.

- **Water Temperature:** 27°C – 30°C
- **Visibility:** 15 – 30 meters
- **Currents:** Mild to strong depending on the site
- **Recommended Certification:** Advanced Open Water
- **Minimum Experience:** 30 logged dives with some current experience preferred

What to Bring

- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 30 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
