Komodo to Bali Expedition – 10D/9N | Up to 25 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Komodo Airport (LBJ) or local hotels in Labuan Bajo. Guests must gather at the designated harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once all guests are onboard. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 10 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Bali the night before. Transfers to Denpasar Ngurah Rai International Airport (DPS) or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 9. Please allow 18–24 hours of surface interval before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather, sea conditions, and optimal diving opportunities. The number of dives is approximate and may be adjusted accordingly.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Labuan Bajo, Komodo

Arrival and check-in. Afternoon check dive in calm waters to ensure equipment setup and comfort in the water.

Day 2 (3 dives + trekking) – Central Komodo

Morning trek to Padar Island for its world-famous viewpoint. Dives in the area with vibrant coral gardens, reef fish, turtles, and possible reef shark encounters.

Day 3 (4 dives + trekking) – Central Komodo

Morning trek on Komodo Island to see the legendary Komodo dragons. Dives in manta cleaning station areas and pristine coral reefs teeming with marine life.

Day 4 (4 dives) – North Komodo

Dives at sites with dramatic pinnacles, large schools of trevallies, reef sharks, and occasional manta sightings.

Day 5 (3 dives) – Sangeang Volcano

Volcanic sand slopes with hydrothermal bubbles, colorful sponges, and unique macro creatures.

**Day 6 (4 dives + trekking) – Satonda Island**

Morning trek to Satonda Crater Lake. Dives around the island showcasing healthy reefs, hard and soft corals, and tropical fish species.

Day 7 (3 dives) – Saleh Bay & Moyo Island

Chance to see whale sharks in Saleh Bay. Afternoon dives at Moyo with hard coral gardens, reef fish, and excellent visibility.

Day 8 (2 dives) – Moyo Island

Coral gardens and clear waters with abundant reef life.

Day 9 (2 dives) – Gili Islands

Reef sites known for green turtles, reef sharks, and colorful coral gardens.

Day 10 – Bali

Early breakfast and check-out. Transfer to Denpasar Ngurah Rai International Airport (DPS) or hotel. No diving this day due to surface interval requirements.

Diving Conditions

- **Best Time to Dive:** April to November
- **Water Temperature:** 26°C – 29°C
- **Visibility:** 15 – 30 meters
- **Currents:** Mild to strong depending on the site
- **Recommended Certification:** Advanced Open Water
- **Minimum Experience:** 20 dives with some current experience preferred

- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
