Raja Ampat North & South Expedition – 11D/10N | Up to 27 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ), Sorong, or local hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 11 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Sorong the night before. Transfers to Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ) or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 10. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1 (0–1 dive) – Sorong Arrival & Check-In

Welcome aboard Neptune One Liveboard. Unpack, relax, and prepare for the adventure. A check dive may be conducted depending on arrival time.

Day 2 (Up to 4 dives) – Misool

Explore vibrant reefs covered in soft corals and swarming with reef fish. Look out for fusiliers, reef sharks, and turtles. A night dive is planned.

Day 3 (Up to 4 dives) – Misool

Seamounts and coral walls, with chances to spot pygmy seahorses, batfish, and hunting trevallies.

Day 4 (3 dives + land tour) – Misool

Dive reef ridges and colorful bommies. In the afternoon, visit Love Lagoon for a short scenic hike.

Day 5 (2 dives + trekking Jellyfish Lake + crossing) – Misool to Penemu

Morning dives exploring underwater caves and submerged rock formations, followed by a visit to Jellyfish Lake for a short trek. Cross overnight to Central Raja Ampat.

**Day 6 (3 dives) – Penemu**

Dive pristine coral gardens, see schooling fish and possibly manta rays. Hike to Piaynemo viewpoint.

Day 7 (3 dives + beach BBQ) – Wayag & Kawe

Northern Raja Ampat offers dramatic underwater topography with a chance to see reef sharks, mobulas, or manta rays. End the day with a beachside BBQ under the stars.

Day 8 (3 dives) – Yanggefo

Diverse dives among mangroves and reefs full of vibrant coral and marine life, from macro to pelagics.

Day 9 (4 dives) – Dampier Strait

Reefs buzzing with barracuda, fusiliers, and jackfish. Night dive at a local jetty for mandarinfish and nocturnal critters.

Day 10 (2 dives) – Mioskon

Final dives over coral slopes and cleaning stations frequented by turtles, napoleon wrasse, and blacktip sharks.

Day 11 – Sorong Disembarkation

Breakfast onboard, then transfer to the airport or hotel. No diving on this day due to flight time requirements.

Diving Conditions

Best Time to Dive: October to April

Water Temperature: 27°C – 30°C

Visibility: 15 – 30 meters

Currents: Mild to strong depending on the site

Recommended Certification: Advanced Open Water

Minimum Experience: 20 dives with some current experience preferred

What to Bring

- Dive certification card & logbook
- Dive computer & surface marker buoy (required)
- Reef-safe sunscreen
- Swimwear, hat, sunglasses
- Light clothing & comfortable footwear
- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
