Raja Ampat South & Central Expedition – 8D/7N | Up to 19 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ), Sorong, or local hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 8 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Sorong the night before. Transfers to Domine Eduard Osok Airport (SOQ) or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 7. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1: Arrival & Check-In (0-1 dive) - Sorong

Meet the crew, settle into your cabin, and complete safety briefings/gear setup. A relaxed afternoon check dive may be offered depending on arrival time.

Day 2: Misool (Up to 3 dives + land tour)

Dive Sites: Dolphin, Love Potion, Mask Cave.

Highlights include stunning soft coral reefs, anthias, reef sharks, and turtles.

Land Activity: Excursion to Jellyfish Lake.

Day 3: Misool - Wayilbatan (Up to 4 dives + land tour)

Dive Sites: Four Kings, Wedding Cake, Gorgonian Passage, Whale Rock (Night Dive).

Land Activity: Trekking to the Love Lagoon viewpoint.

Day 4: Misool to Central Crossing (Up to 2 dives)

Dive Sites: Magic Mountain, Boo Window.

Dive vibrant pinnacles and soft coral forests with chances for manta rays and turtles. In the afternoon, the boat begins the crossing to Central Raja Ampat.

Day 5: Central Raja Ampat - Piaynemo Area (Up to 4 dives + land tour)

Dive Sites: My Reef, Melissa's Garden, Kerou Channel, Batu Rufus (Night Dive).



Land Activity: Hike to the iconic Piaynemo viewpoint to view the world-class coral gardens and dramatic rock formations.

Day 6: Gam & Dampier Strait (Up to 4 dives)

Dive Sites: Mayhem, Manta Ridge, Manta Sandy, Arborek Jetty (Night Dive).

Spectacular reef dives featuring coral bommies, schooling sweetlips, snappers, reef sharks, and premier manta ray cleaning stations.

Day 7: Mansuar (Up to 2 dives + land activity)

Dive Sites: Sawandarek Jetty, Cape Kri. Final dives along biodiversity-rich reefs featuring dense schools of fusiliers, wobbegong sharks, or manta rays.

Land Activity: Blue River Kali Biru tour. (Diving ends by 12:00 PM for flight surface intervals).

Day 8: Disembarkation - Sorong

Enjoy a final breakfast onboard before your included transfer to the Sorong airport or local hotel by 10:00 AM.

Diving Conditions

Best Time to Dive: October to April

Water Temperature: 27°C – 30°C

Visibility: 15 – 30 meters

Currents: Mild to strong depending on the site

Recommended Certification: Advanced Open Water

Minimum Experience: 20 dives with some current experience preferred

What to Bring

- Dive certification card & logbook
- Dive computer & surface marker buoy (required)
- Reef-safe sunscreen
- Swimwear, hat, sunglasses
- Light clothing & comfortable footwear
- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
