Crossing Trip: Wakatobi to Alor – 10D/9N | Up to 25 dives

Embarkation & Disembarkation

Embarkation: Pick-up is scheduled before 12:00 PM from Betoambari Airport (BUW), Bau Bau, or nearby hotels. Guests must gather at the harbor by 12:00 PM. Embarkation will begin once everyone has arrived. Schedule may adjust due to flight delays or unforeseen circumstances.

Disembarkation: Day 10 by 10:00 AM. The boat returns to Alor the night before. Transfers to Mali Airport (ARD), Alor, or local hotels are included.

Last Dive: Scheduled by 12:00 PM on Day 9. Please allow 18–24 hours before flying.

Sample Itinerary

Final schedule may vary depending on weather and sea conditions. The number of dives is approximate and subject to change for safety and optimal dive experience.

Day 1 (1 dive) – Arrival & Check-In, Bau Bau

Welcome aboard Neptune One in Bau Bau. After check-in and safety briefing, gear up for a relaxed check dive to get familiar with your setup and the conditions.

Day 2 (Up to 3 dives) – Wangi-Wangi

Start your adventure with vibrant coral gardens and gentle reefs. Calm conditions make this an ideal introduction to Wakatobi's biodiversity.

Day 3 (Up to 4 dives) – Hoga

Explore Hoga's spectacular coral ridges, sea fans, and macro critters. This area is a dream for underwater photographers with its dramatic structures and biodiversity.

Day 4 (Up to 3 dives) – Tomia

Dive steep coral slopes, bommies, and sandy patches rich in marine life. Keep an eye out for eagle rays, turtles, and schools of fusiliers.

Day 5 (Up to 3 dives) – Tomia & Karang Sawa

Continue exploring the Wakatobi reef system. Expect high visibility, swirling anthias, pristine hard and soft coral formations, and pelagic sightings.



Day 6 (Up to 3 dives) – Komba Volcano

Experience black sand diving at its best. This volcanic island features geothermal bubbles, unusual rock structures, and excellent macro opportunities.

Day 7 (Up to 4 dives) – Pura Island

A full day of diving around Pura's diverse sites—reef walls, bommies, and muck dives. Look for pygmy seahorses, ribbon eels, nudibranchs, and reef sharks.

Day 8 (Up to 3 dives) – Pura Island

A full diving day with rich reef walls, bommies, and critter-filled slopes. Look out for pygmy seahorses, frogfish, ribbon eels, and maybe a reef shark or two.

Day 9 (2 dives + land excursion) – Pantar & Sika Islands

A relaxed diving day with beautiful coral reefs and the chance to see larger marine life. In the afternoon, visit a local village and keep an eye out for dugongs in the bay. These shallower dives help prepare your body for flying.

Day 10 – Disembarkation in Alor

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast before transferring to Mali Airport (ARD) or local hotels. No diving today to allow a safe surface interval before flying.

Diving Conditions

- **Best Time to Dive:** April to November
- **Water Temperature:** 27°C – 30°C
- **Visibility:** 20 – 35 meters
- **Currents:** Mild to moderate depending on site
- **Recommended Certification:** Advanced Open Water
- **Minimum Experience:** 20 logged dives

What to Bring

- Dive certification card & logbook
- Dive computer & surface marker buoy (required)
- Reef-safe sunscreen
- Swimwear, hat, sunglasses
- Light clothing & comfortable footwear
- Personal toiletries & medications
- Travel adaptor (220V, EU plug)
- Passport (minimum 6-month validity)
- Copy of travel and dive insurance

Key Notes

- Travel & dive insurance are mandatory
- Minimum of 20 dives and Advanced certification recommended
- No diving allowed within 18 hours of flight time
- Do not touch or collect marine life—respect the reef
- Notify us in advance of any dietary restrictions or medical concerns
