INTRODUCTION

RAJA AMPAT

This national park in the most eastern part of the Indonesian archipelago surely is one of the most magnificent place in the world.

Raja Ampat literally translates to "Four Kings". Myth said, once upon a time, a woman found 7 eggs. 4 of them hatched and they became kings of their own islands. Waigeo, Salawati, East Misool and West Misool... known today as Raja Ampat. The other 3 turned into a ghost, a woman and a stone.

Between 2001 and 2002 a team of experts from The International Conservation, The Nature Conservacy, National Oceanography Foundation of Indonesia (LON) and Indonesian Science Foundation (LIPI) discovered that Raja Ampat holds 540 types of Hard Coral. Thats 75% of the total number of Hard Coral species in the world! Over 1000 species of coral fish and 700 mollusks can also be found here.

The highlights of Raja Ampat and you can experience in this itinerary includes, diving in the beautiful coral garden of Melissa Garden, diving with giant mantas & reef sharsk, the wobegong, snorkeling in the jelly fish lake, hiking to the love lagoon.


